The Castle in Fort Totten is one of the finest surviving examples in New York City of the Gothic Revival castellated style architecture. Completed in 1887, the building served as the base Officers' Mess Hall and Club for the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers School of Application. BHS 60th Anniversary Swing Dance Party

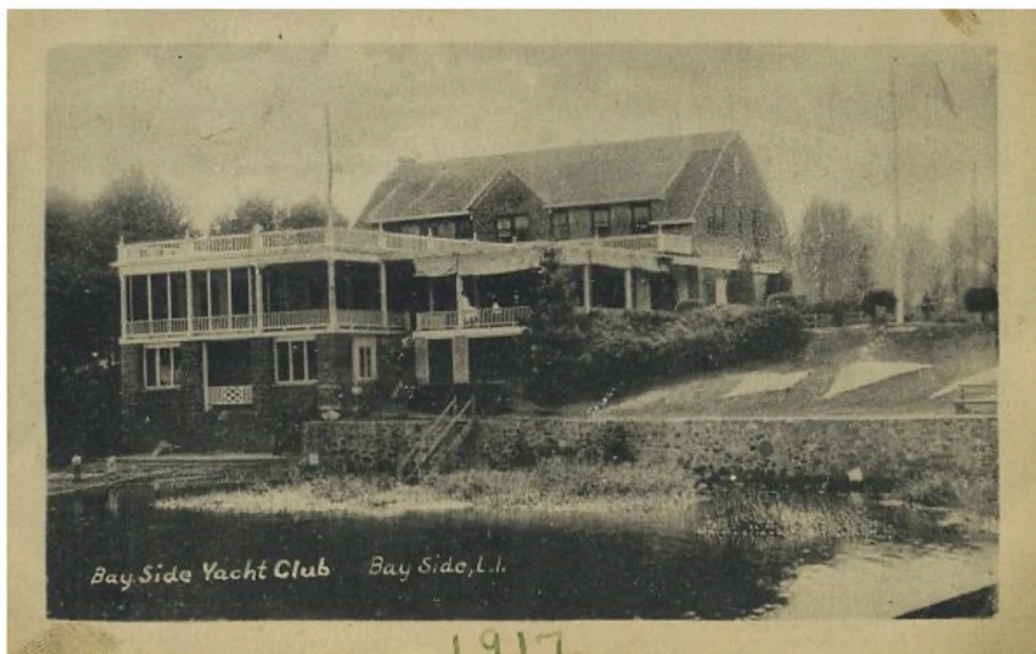
Friday, April 26th | 7:00 – 9:30 PM
